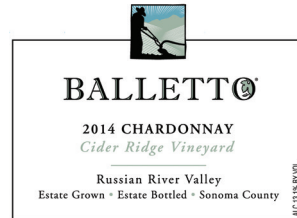

CHARDONNAY: 2014 OR EARLIER

★ **RouteStock 2014 Chardonnay** (Carneros; \$16). Without an ounce of fat, this tightly knit wine offers sparkling minerality that brightens apple and pear on the palate. Well-integrated oak adds cream and spice notes.

Balletto 2014 Cider Ridge Vineyard Estate Grown Chardonnay (Russian River Valley, Sonoma County; \$42). Floral aromas lead to a bright, refined palate of lemon tart, lime, and mandarin orange. Low oak and nervy acidity make this an energetic, food-friendly Chardonnay.

Calstar Cellars 2013 Chardonnay (Sonoma Coast, Sonoma County; \$29). Toasty aromas lead to a mouth-watering palate of citrus and green apple. Brisk acidity balances a spicy oak character, with a hint of minerality on the finish.

Center of Effort 2014 Chardonnay (Edna Valley; \$35). Citrus blossom aromas and lively lemon custard, peach, and pear flavors mark this medium-bodied, lovely-textured wine, with a hint of oak and a fresh finish.

Chalk Hill 2014 Chardonnay (Chalk Hill; \$42). With very ripe pear and apple flavors, lavish oak toast and spice, and a weighty mouth-feel, this one is for the bigger-is-better crowd. Cellar-worthy.

Davis Bynum 2014 River West Vineyard Chardonnay (Russian River Valley, Sonoma County; \$25). Intriguing notes of fig and cashew butter combine with juicy pear and apple fruit in this nicely oaked wine with a creamy midpalate followed by a brisk finish.

Fleur 2014 Chardonnay (Carneros; \$18). Refreshingly lean-bodied and bright, this wine is marked by a lemony, pleasantly briny flavor, with toasty oak adding complexity to a lingering finish.

La Pitchoune 2014 Pratt Vineyard Chardonnay (Russian River Valley; \$58). Lean and elegant, this Chardonnay adds toasty, yeasty, and creamy components to Meyer lemon and Gravenstein apple flavors.

Maldonado 2014 Parr Vineyard Chardonnay (Sonoma County; \$32). Chablis fans will appreciate this crisp, lemony Chardonnay, with hints of sea breeze and seashell minerality that add interest to a slightly creamy midpalate.

Robert Mondavi Winery 2014 Chardonnay (Napa Valley; \$20). Medium body; juicy apple, pear, and citrus flavors; and moderate oak influence make this a fine foil for a wide range of foods, including grilled fish and roast chicken.

Sonoma-Cutrer 2014 "The Cutrer" Chardonnay (Russian River Valley, Sonoma County; \$32). Great energy, length, and minerality elevate citrus aromas and flavors on the palate, with oak spice and texture on the finish.

Thirty-Seven 2014 Chardonnay (Sonoma Coast; \$36). Lovers of oak will appreciate the smoke, toast, and spice in this full-bodied Chardonnay. Ripe apple and pear flavors linger through a persistent finish.

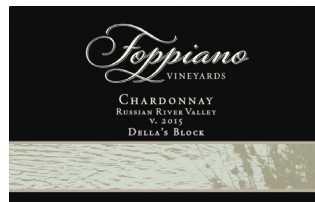
★ **Lucia Highlands 2015 Kelly's Vineyard Chardonnay** (Santa Lucia Highlands; \$25). Fresh citrus and yellow stone-fruit aromas and flavors have an intriguing minerally edge; hints of oak and yeasty brioche add dimension. Beautifully integrated and focused, this wine could be mistaken for white Burgundy.

Artesa 2015 Chardonnay (Los Carneros; \$20). Crowd-pleasing for its bright, rounded lemon-pudding, pineapple, peach, and apple palate and mouthwatering finish.

Buena Vista 2015 Chardonnay (Carneros; \$20). Oak toast and spice accent luscious tropical flavors in this polished, complete wine.

Ferrari-Carano 2015 "Tré Terre" Chardonnay (Russian River Valley, Sonoma County; \$28). Crisp Meyer lemon, green apple, and tropical fruit dance at the front of the palate, which evolves into richness and vanillin oak, followed by a clean, crisp finish.

Ferrari-Carano 2015 "Fiorella" Chardonnay (Russian River Valley, Sonoma County; \$36). Plush and expressive, with notes of lemongrass and sandalwood layered under vibrant lemon, green-apple, and tangerine flavors. Oak plays a minor role in this lively wine.

Foppiano Vineyards 2015 Della's Block Chardonnay (Russian River Valley; \$37). Toasty, creamy vanillin oak frames lemon-curd, pear, and pineapple flavors in this medium-bodied wine that finishes with verve.

Fullerton 2015 "Five Faces" Chardonnay (Willamette Valley, Oregon; \$33). Tense acidity frames the spicy pear, lemon-curd, and green-apple character of this lean, bright wine. A hint of hazelnut comes from judicious oak aging.

Main & Geary Vintners 2015 Chardonnay (Sonoma County; \$19). Solid in every way, with a keen balance of juicy pear and apple character, moderate oak influence, and firm acidity.

Patz & Hall 2015 Chardonnay (Sonoma Coast; \$40). Ripe, concentrated apple, pear, and lemon-meringue-pie flavors are balanced by brisk acidity, making for a succulent finish.

Rodney Strong Estate Vineyards 2015 Chardonnay (Chalk Hill, Sonoma County; \$22). Delicate nectarine, citrus, and fennel flavors gain depth and complexity from moderately toasty, spicy oak. This one is classy and nuanced.

Sea Bird 2015 Sangiacomo Vineyard Chardonnay (Sonoma Coast; \$25). Toasty, spicy notes accent bright, crisp citrus, green apple, and tropical fruit. With brisk acidity, this Chardonnay has a long, mouthwatering finish.

Sonoma-Cutrer 2015 Chardonnay (Sonoma Coast, Sonoma County; \$22). This elegant, chiseled Chardonnay is subtle and lighter-bodied, with oak well in the background. Lemon-lime flavors and mouthwatering acidity make it extremely versatile at the table—even with oysters.

Stoller Family 2015 Estate Grown Reserve Chardonnay (Dundee Hills; \$35). Chalky minerality and laserlike acidity keep bright green apple and underripe pear flavors crisp and refreshing.
