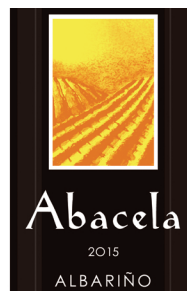

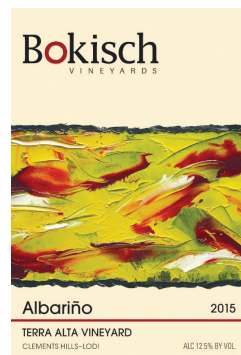

★ **Abacela 2015 Albariño** (Umpqua Valley, Southern Oregon; \$21). This Oregon take on the white wine of Spain's Rias Baixas region is a home run, with vibrant white peach, pear, and citrus fruit and complex hits of mineral, chamomile, and white pepper.

**Bokisch Vineyards 2015 Terra Alta Vineyard Albariño** (Clements Hills, Lodi; \$18). Tropical flavors, including passion fruit and pineapple—plus vibrant acidity and a hint of minerality—plead the case for Lodi's ability to produce outstanding white wines.

★ **Wildstock 2014 Chardonnay** (Oregon; \$20). Oak typically lends texture to Chardonnay, yet none was needed for this voluptuous, vibrant wine with Meyer lemon, red apple, and beeswax character and a surprisingly rich mouth-feel.

**Kim Crawford 2014 Unoaked Chardonnay** (East Coast, New Zealand; \$17). This Kiwi brand was among the first to bring unoaked Chardonnay to the U.S., in the late 1990s. It's a champ for its rich texture, juicy lemon curd palate, and crisp, refreshing finish.

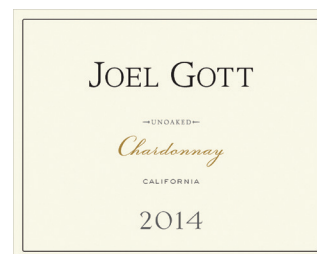

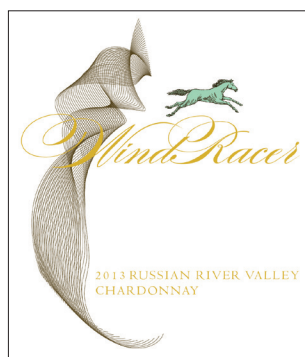

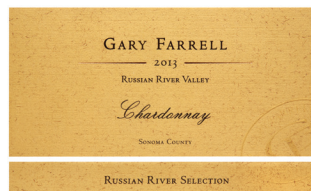

★ **WindRacer 2013 Chardonnay** (Russian River Valley; \$40). This round, creamy wine also has great structure, with its lemon drop and lemon cream character supported by subtle oak toast and spice and a crisp finish. Elegance in a glass.

**Clos Pegase 2013 Mitsuko’s Vineyard Estate Grown Chardonnay** (Carneros, Napa Valley; \$30). There’s an attractive lemon-oil aroma and texture to this tightly wound wine that, while tasty now, is also a candidate for the cellar. Drink it now with any grilled white fish or shellfish.

**DeLoach Vineyards 2013 “OFS” Chardonnay** (Russian River Valley; \$32). At once full-bodied and elegant, this Chard gets its richness from baked apple and ripe pear, its verve from lemon curd-like acidity, and its mouth-feel from careful oak use and rounded tannins.

**Dutton-Goldfield 2013 Dutton Ranch, Walker Hill Vineyard Chardonnay** (Green Valley of Russian River Valley, Sonoma County; \$50). This wine has it all: richness, a dab of butter, hints of caramel and toast, and succulent lemon, tropical, and stone fruit flavors. Vibrant acidity knits it all together.

**Gary Farrell 2013 Russian River Selection Chardonnay** (Russian River Valley, Sonoma County; \$35). Full-bodied and nicely oaked, this one shows the lemon curd and green apple character of Russian River Valley Chard, with vanilla, spice, and tangy acidity.

**La Rochelle 2013 Ferrington Vineyard “Recherché Reserve” Chardonnay** (Anderson Valley; \$65). A great vineyard yielded this finely balanced wine with oak in the background, allowing the brilliant citrus, green apple, apricot, and mandarin orange fruit to shine. Oak’s contributions include sweet spice and vanilla.

**Ron Rubin 2013 Chardonnay** (Russian River Valley; \$20). Minerality and high acidity here are reminiscent of Chablis, yet the fruit is pure sunny Sonoma—ripe apple, pear, and lemon. Creaminess on the mid-palate softens any edges.

**Russian River Vineyards 2013 Chardonnay** (Russian River Valley, Sonoma County; \$38). An oak-driven, viscous wine balanced by exuberant apricot, peach, and Pippin apple fruit, plus spice and firm acidity. A great match for roast chicken and lobster risotto.

**Sanctuary 2013 Chardonnay** (Russian River Valley; \$35). In a buttery, toasty style, this one turns on the charm on the finish, with citrus and lemon curd intensity and a pure, fresh finish.

**Thirty-Seven 2013 Chardonnay** (Sonoma Coast; \$36). Although toast and caramel dominate the nose, pure lemon cream, pear, and apple flavors explode on the palate; brisk and mouth-watering.

★ **Hughes Family Vineyards 2014 Chardonnay** (Sonoma Mountain; \$40). Apricots, citrus, and pineapple flavors are buoyed by beautiful minerality.

**Beauregard 2014 Bald Mountain Vineyard Estate Grown Chardonnay** (Ben Lomond Mountain; \$45). Lime, peach, and pear flavors get a blast of vibrant acidity in this brisk yet luscious wine.

**Beauregard 2014 Beauregard Ranch Estate Grown Chardonnay** (Ben Lomond Mountain; \$55). Lovely rounded citrus flavors on the palate are set off by aromas of Golden Delicious apple, pear, and hints of tropical fruit.

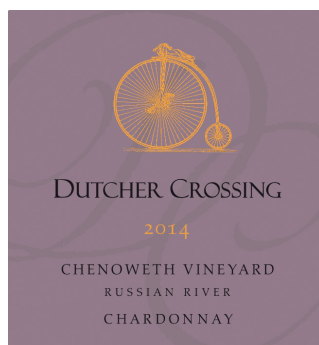
**Bouchaine 2014 Bacchus Collection Estate Vineyard “Chene d’Argent” Chardonnay** (Carneros, Napa Valley; \$30). This bright, tangy, no-oak wine offers pure, crisp Meyer lemon, red apple, and nectarine flavors that are slightly sweet, balanced by racy acidity on the finish. Superb with steamed cracked crab.

**Bridge 1904 2014 Chardonnay** (Napa Valley; \$28). Crisp citrus and apple fruit carry this wine, with a yin-yang balance of creaminess and tart lemon drop bite.

**Dancin 2015 “Chaine” Chardonnay** (Southern Oregon; \$29). Fermented in neutral oak and without a softening secondary (malolactic) fermentation, this light, bright wine allows its pure pineapple and citrus character to stand out. Nicely balanced, with an inviting floral note.

**Dutcher Crossing 2014 Chenoweth Vineyard Chardonnay** (Russian River; \$36). Textbook cool-climate Sonoma Coast Chardonnay, with vibrant lemon, green apple, and kaffir lime; quartzlike minerality; and a mouthwatering lemony finish.

**Ernest 2014 Black Emerald, Green Valley Ranch Vineyards “The Bombardier” Chardonnay** (Russian River Valley; \$47). This richly textured, toasty wine offers bold pear, apple, and citrus aromas and flavors, at just 13.5% alcohol.

**Estancia 2014 Chardonnay** (Monterey County; \$12). Medium-weight, straightforward, and easy going, this well-priced Chardonnay from Monterey has juicy apple and tropical fruit character and a clean, fresh taste.

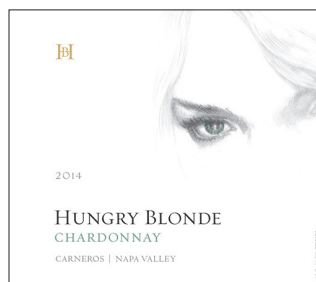

**donnay** (Napa Valley; \$18). This excellent-value wine from Napa Valley is medium-bodied, creamy, and rich, with golden apple and nectarine character accented with creamy oak and juicy acidity.

### Graton Ridge Cellars 2014

**Chardonnay** (Russian River Valley, Sonoma County; \$34). Here’s the fresh, lively side of Chardonnay, with bright lemon curd and green apple character. The texture is silky and fine, making for an elegant, refreshing drink.

(Carneros, Napa Valley; \$30). An elegant package that delivers lush layers of sweet lemon, hazelnuts, and a lingering finish.

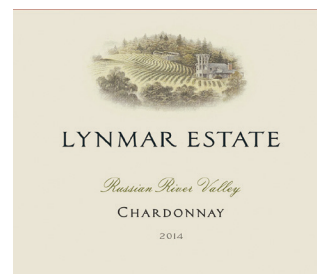

**Rancho Sisquoc 2014 Flood Family Vineyards Chardonnay** (Santa Barbara County; \$20). Pretty more than powerful, this Chardonnay has zesty lemon and green apple flavors, a hint of butter, and a long, refreshing finish. You couldn't go wrong with petrale sole with lemon butter and capers.



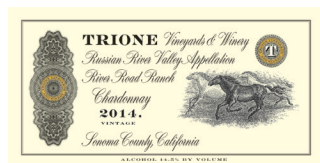

Merlot, Cabernet Franc, and a splash of Cabernet Sauvignon come together in this polished wine, with luscious dark fruit and hints of sarsaparilla, mint, and dark chocolate. Elegant now, it will also improve for a decade or more.

**Adelaida 2013 Viking Estate Vineyard "Viking" Red** (Adelaida District, Paso Robles; \$40). This one boasts a splendid integration of ripe fruit and toasty oak. Seamless and solidly structured, it remains vibrant, though it will benefit from a few years in the cellar.

**Almquist Family Vintners 2010 "Griffin's Cuvée" Red** (Washington; \$30). This Washington wine conjures Bordeaux with its leaner profile: forest floor character, herbs, tobacco, black pepper, and brisk acidity, with pretty violet aromas for balance. Hello, leg of lamb.

**Arbor Bench Vineyards 2010 “Reflections” Meritage** (Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County; \$50). This six-year-old wine has held together beautifully, with agreeable mintiness, chewy tannins, blackberry fruit, and a spicy, satisfying finish. It's in peak form.

**Arbor Bench Vineyards 2013 Meritage** (Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County; \$50). Gentle leafy herbs and smoke aromas lead to a rich, slightly jammy mouthful of red berry and black cherry flavors. Crisp acidity keeps the fruit plump and juicy, and the tannins are firm yet seamless.

**Blackbird Vineyards 2013 “Paramour” Red** (Napa Valley; \$135). Even with a similar composition to the winery's “Illustration” wine, “Paramour” is a bit less obvious, with floral, coffee, and cedar aromas and a fine, elegant palate of black cherry, spice, herbs, and minerals. It's round, silky, and satisfying now—and for at least five years.

**Chateau Ste. Michelle 2012 “Artist Series” Red** (Columbia Valley; \$65). With this bottle, big is beautiful. Its seamless texture, generous vanilla and smoke from oak, and concentration meld into a full-bodied, hedonistic wine, lush with ripe black cherry and blackberry flavors.

**DeLille Cellars 2013 “Chaleur Estate” Red** (Red Mountain; \$80). Textbook concentration and big tannic structure from Washington's tiny Red Mountain AVA. Ripe blueberry, black cherry, licorice, chocolate, and vanilla notes round out the picture. 67 percent Cabernet Sauvignon, plus Merlot and Cabernet Franc.

**Double T 2013 Red** (Napa Valley; \$25). This affordable Napa Valley blend comes from Trefethen. It's easy to drink, with velvety tannins; bright, lively red and black fruit; and a subtle herbal character.

**Grey Wolf Vineyards and Cellars 2013 “Lineage” Red** (Paso Robles; \$38). Love berry cobbler? This wine's for you. It has a sweet core of boysenberry and cherry fruit wrapped in toasted baking spice, with solid structure and a bright, lively finish.
